Please go to www.studyspanish.com and click on “Grammar” and look at the list of units on the left. Some items you might know, but didn’t know its spelling, or the rules, so please don’t skip any items. You must **read/ process/study/learn** each theme, and for each one, you must take the Basic quizzes for the unit that consists of 20 questions (only do the first 20 questions, please). The form “vosotros” should be studied, as it is part of the Spanish language.

When you finish each quiz, you should see a small results window with the word “Congratulations! 100% Correct!” In order for you to see the results window with your score, you must create an account (it’s free) otherwise, you won’t be able to see it.

Please print one for each quiz you take, and hand them to me on the first day of classes. If there are any mistakes, you will be prompted to correct them before printing the page. Remember that you must only hand in the results that are 100% correct.
