



2019-2020 Tuition Credits & Programs

In addition to awarding more than \$2 million in need-based financial aid, SDJA offers a variety of Tuition Credits and Programs, as outlined below.

Early Enrollment Credit

Families who re-enroll by February 1, 2019 (or apply for tuition assistance by February 1, 2019) are eligible for a \$1,000 credit off SDJA's published tuition rate. This credit may be combined with both the Open Door Program *and* the highest value Tuition Credit listed below.

Open Door Program

Children entering Kindergarten or 9th grade for the 2019-2020 school year receive a 50% reduction in SDJA's published tuition rate for 4 consecutive years. This program may be combined with both the Early Enrollment Credit *and* the highest value Tuition Credit listed below.

TUITION CREDITS

The following Tuition Credits are designed to recognize the many ways in which our families help us build and strengthen our Jewish community. A student who qualifies for more than one of the following credits will be awarded the highest value credit only. The highest valued credit may be combined with both the Early Enrollment Credit *and* the Open Door Program, as noted above.

Multiple Child Credit

Families with three or more children in attendance receive a 25% Tuition Credit for the third child, OR 50% for the fourth child. The credit applies to the youngest child, unless one or more of the children are in an Open Door grade, in which case the credit applies to the youngest child in an Open Door grade.

Rabbinic Credit

Children of active San Diego Jewish community pulpit Rabbis and Cantors receive a 50% tuition credit.

Employee Credit

Children of full-time SDJA employees receive a 25% tuition credit. Part-time employees receive a prorated credit.

Jewish Professional Credit

Children with at least one parent or grandparent employed by a recognized San Diego Jewish communal agency receive a 25% tuition credit. Contact our Admissions Department for additional information.
